Object of the Game

To be the player with the most number of situation tricks. A situation trick consists for example of one situation card and four excuse cards.

Wild Cards

A wild card allows a player to make up his/her own excuse and can be played at any time during the game.

Game Play

1. Separate the 60 excuse cards from the 30 situation cards. Lay the 30 situation cards face down in the centre.
2. Shuffle the 60 excuse cards and deal 5 cards to each player face down. Each player looks at their own cards.

3. Turn over the top situation card. Each player plays his best excuse for that particular situation by laying his card face down in front of him.
4. When all players have decided on their excuse, all the cards are turned over.
5. All players then vote on the best excuse. The winner collects the situation trick for that round.
6. If a winner is not decided, turn over the next situation card and re-vote using the original excuses.
7. At the end of play, players total their tricks, the player with the highest number of tricks is the winner.
